The Freeport School District assigns students to stops based upon the registered students in the area. Some students may have to walk further than the closet corner, and stops may change from year to year. Stops are designated so that they are located as central as possible to all students riding the bus. The most dangerous time for children is when the bus starts and stops, so reducing the number of times a bus stops in a neighborhood helps to improve student safety.

Every request is reviewed and a decision is made within 1 week of receipt. If you do not agree with the decision you may write a letter of appeal to the Board of Education.
